THE VISION

Our vision is to help young women build a foundation of principles that will be a lifelong guide for successful living in their move towards independence. It is the desire of the home mentors to provide an experience that is enjoyable and that has a positive impact on the lives of young people. As well, Crystal's Home staff will promote physical, spiritual and emotional health



THE HISTORY

Crystal's Home was named in memory of Crystal Paskemin, a former resident of Sweetgrass First Nation. As a youth, Crystal's passion was for young women who did not have a healthy and safe place to live.



Her dream was to become a Social Worker- helping young women to find homes, to find safety, stability and a chance at success. While accepted to the University of Saskatchewan, and working in Saskatoon, Crystal's life came to a tragic end.

Crystal's dream of helping young women did not die with her. Staff members at Living Faith Chapel in North Battleford knew Crystal's desire to help young women. Through hard work, dedication and persistence, Living Faith Chapel in cooperation with the Ministry of Social Services and the National Homelessness Initiative, found a way to make that happen. Following an extensive home renovation project to prepare the home, Crystal's Home was opened in January of 2008.



THE PROGRAM

24/7 staff provide a safe nurturing environment for youth which accommodates a total of five beds.

Ensures that acceptable standards of care are maintained in meeting the youths' physical, emotional and social needs.

Encourages youth to participate in suitable pre-vocational, educational, recreational and cultural programs to enhance their intellectual, social and moral development.

Takes appropriate steps to achieve jointly established goals and objectives set out for each participant.

Works closely with community organizations to ensure that each girl receives all necessary services and supports.
